

# Does Anything Eat Shit?

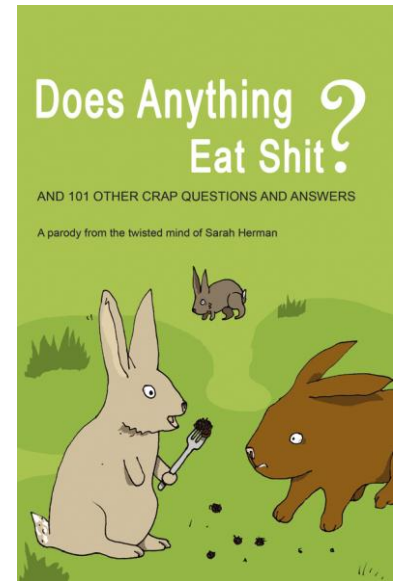
