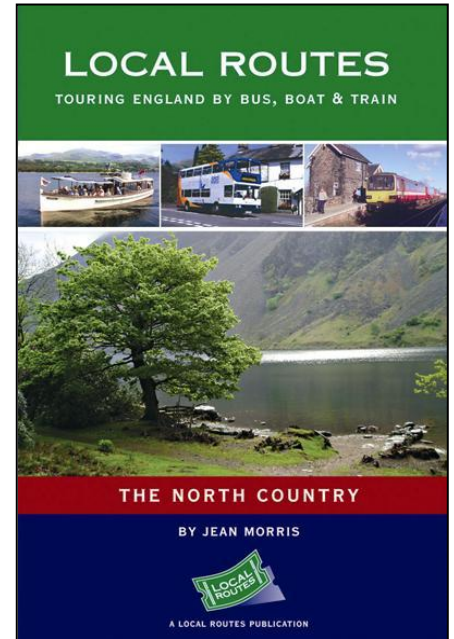


# LOCAL ROUTES: THE NORTH COUNTRY
